AN ACT RESTRICTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FROM CONSTRUCTING A SEWERAGE TREATMENT FACILITY WITHIN A FIVE MILE RADIUS OF AN EXISTING ONE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 803 of the acts of 1972 is hereby amended  
2 by inserting, in line 8, after the words "so-called", the following  
3 words:— provided, that no sewerage treatment facility shall be  
4 constructed within a five mile radius of any existing one.
