## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

### AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF NON-RETURNABLE GLASS CONTAINERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 307 the following section: —

3 *Section 307A.* Except as otherwise provided by law, no  
4 beverage shall be sold, offered for sale, or held with intent to  
5 sell within the commonwealth which is packaged in a non-  
6 returnable glass container. Whoever violates the provisions of  
7 this section shall be punished by a fine of one hundred dollars.
