AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRAVEL ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES
OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, or any
2 rule or regulation made by the division of personnel and stand-
3 ardization, any employee of the commonwealth who is entitled
4 to receive compensation for travel shall be reimbursed on the
5 basis of the number of miles traveled from such employee's home
6 to the location of the place where he is assigned, including the
7 return trip to his home.
