To accompany the petition of Harold F. Congdon for legislation to authorize the construction by the Department of Public Works of a certain way in the town of Salisbury. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF A CERTAIN WAY IN THE TOWN OF SALISBURY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized
2 and directed to lay out and construct a certain way con-
3 necting Salisbury Beach Reservation road, which runs
4 from Salisbury square to said reservation, with Murray
5 street at Cable avenue, in the town of Salisbury. The
6 department may acquire by purchase or by eminent do-
7 main such land, if any, as may be needed for the con-
8 struction of said way. For the purposes of the act, said
9 department may expend such sums as may be appropri-
10 ated therefor.
