

HOUSE No. 1090

By Mr. Leary of Boston (by request), petition of John I. Fitzgerald that the Department of Public Works be authorized to sell or convey to the city of Boston certain land along Charles River Basin in said city. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act authorizing the Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth, to sell or convey, to the City of Boston, Certain Land on the Charles River in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works of the
2 commonwealth is hereby authorized to sell and con-
3 vey to the city of Boston, for park, playground,
4 bathing or stadium purposes, at a price mutually
5 agreed upon by said department and the mayor of
6 the city of Boston, or for a nominal sum, land and
7 flats owned by the commonwealth under control of
8 the department of public works fronting on the
9 Charles river and bounded by land owned by the
10 city of Boston, now known as Lomasney park, and
11 by land now owned by the Boston and Maine Rail-

12 road and by Nashua street, and by the pier and
13 bulkhead line in said river.

14 The terms and conditions of any sale authorized by
15 this act shall be subject to the approval of the gov-
16 ernor and the council.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
