

By Mr. Lawless of Orleans, petition of Robert C. Lawless relative to the issuance of seasonal all alcoholic beverages licenses or seasonal wine and malt beverages licenses. Government Regulations.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO SEASONAL, ALL-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE OR WINE AND MALT BEVERAGE LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 Section 17B, as appearing in the 1989 Official Edition, and
3 inserting in place thereof the following section: —

4 Section 17B. In any city or town which accepts or has accepted
5 previously the provisions of this section, a local licensing
6 authority which granted seasonal all-alcoholic beverages or wine
7 and malt beverage licenses as set forth in Section 15, on or before
8 January 1, 1989, is hereby authorized to grant, in addition to the
9 number of licenses which may be issued pursuant to Section 17,
10 but subject to all other provisions of this Chapter, additional all-
11 alcoholic beverages licenses per year; provided, however, that
12 said additional licenses shall be granted only to holders of said
13 seasonal licenses; provided, further, that the holder of said
14 seasonal license surrenders such license; and provided, further,
15 that the total number of seasonal licenses that the local licensing
16 authority may issue pursuant to said Section 17 shall be reduced
17 by one for each new license issued.
