In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three:

**AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAPER RECYCLING.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any rule, regulation, general law, or spe-
- 2 cial law to the contrary all departments, boards, agencies, and
- 3 commissions, including the General Court, shall recycle all
- 4 their printed waste material which is suitable for that pur-
- 5 pose, by selling it to businesses engaged in paper recycling
- 6 operations.
