The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT TO CONSERVE ELECTRIC ENERGY AND WATER AS WELL AS THE APPURTENANCES COMMON TO THE SITUATIONS DESIGNATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any other law to the contrary notwithstanding, and starting on
2 July One, Nineteen Hundred and Seventy Eight, no entity which
3 uses water for public display or other kinds of ornamental
4 purposes may be operated by the Commonwealth or any political
5 subdivision of it; and further: no structure or building to be built by
6 the Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions, may
7 incorporate in any part of the structures or the surrounding
8 grounds any entity which uses water or other pumped liquid for
9 display or ornamental purposes.
