AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE HOLDING OF THE SESSIONS OF THE PROBATE COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF ESSEX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

7 August; at Lawrence, the second Monday of each month
8 except August; at Haverhill, the fourth Monday of each
9 month except August.
