## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF ALL EXPENSES OF CITIES AND TOWNS FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC WELFARE PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of chapter 115 of the General Laws as appearing  
2 in section 1 of chapter 548 of the acts of 1946, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following sentence:—Subject to such deci-  
5 sion and allowance, all the amounts of veterans' benefits paid  
6 to applicants having settlements in the cities or towns  
7 making such payments, and all of the amounts of veterans'  
8 benefits paid to other applicants, and all of the expenses  
9 attending the payment of such benefits, shall be paid by the  
10 commonwealth to the several cities and towns on or before  
11 November tenth in the year after such expenditures.
