AN ACT PROHIBITING TRANSPORTATION OF PUPILS WITHOUT THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 68 the following section: —

3 *Section 68A.* No pupil shall be transported to and from any
4 public school without the written consent of his parents or
5 legal guardian if he has no parents.
