AN ACT DESIGNATING A PORTION OF THE STRANDWAY DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE WILLIAM J. DAY BOULEVARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 That portion of Columbia road in the South Boston  
2 district of the city of Boston between Columbia circle  
3 and Castle island, known as the Strandway, shall be  
4 known and designated as the William J. Day boulev-  
5 vard, and suitable markers or tablets bearing said  
6 designation shall be erected and maintained thereon  
7 by the metropolitan district commission.
