## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF AGNES DOHERTY OF MALDEN.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a  
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth, and after an  
3 appropriation has been made therefor from the High-  
4 way Fund, there shall be allowed and paid from the  
5 treasury of the commonwealth, with the approval of  
6 the department of public works, to Agnes Doherty  
7 of Malden the sum of seventy-five hundred and thirty  
8 dollars in full compensation for certain property  
9 owned by said Agnes Doherty, which was taken by  
10 eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine of the  
11 General Laws by said department in connection with  
12 a state highway in the city of Malden. No payment  
13 shall be made hereunder until there shall have been  
14 filed with the comptroller an agreement signed by  
15 said Agnes Doherty that the amount, if any, paid or  
16 to be paid for legal services rendered in connection  
17 with the passage of this resolve shall not exceed ten  
18 per cent of said sum.
