AN ACT FOR COMPENSATORY TIME OFF FOR PERSONS REQUIRED TO  
WORK ON A SKELETON FORCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

- 1 Subsection (6) of section 45 of chapter 30 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section
- 3 the following:—Said rules shall provide that persons who
- 4 are required to work on a skeleton force shall be given
- 5 compensatory time off therefor.
