By Mr. Quinn of Boston, petition of Robert H. Quinn that operators of motorcycles and similar vehicles be required to wear iridescent clothing while driving at night. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT REQUIRING OPERATORS OF MOTORCYCLES AND SIMILAR VEHICLES TO WEAR IRIDESCENT CLOTHING WHILE DRIVING AT NIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 16, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edi-
3 tion, the following section:—

4 *Section 16A.* No person shall operate a motorcycle, as de-
5 fined in section one of this chapter, between the hours com-
6 mencing one half hour after sunset and ending one half hour
7 before sunrise, unless he shall wear a jacket, tunic or crossbelt
8 made of iridescent material approved by the registrar.
