AN ACT REQUIRING ANNUAL PHYSICAL EXAMINATION OF NURSES
AND DOCTORS EMPLOYED AT STATE INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the department of public health shall require
3 all nurses and doctors permanently employed at state institu-
4 tions to take an annual physical examination. This act shall
5 take effect upon its passage.
