AN ACT RELATIVE TO CAMPAIGN ADVERTISING BY CERTAIN  
CORPORATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 55 of the General Laws as most recently amended  
2 is hereby further amended by adding the following section  
3 8A: —

4 No public or private corporation carrying on the business  
5 of a telegraph, telephone, gas, electric light, heat, power or  
6 water company shall include in or as part of its regular cus-  
7 tomer billing material, any other material, information or ad-  
8 vertising for the purpose of aiding, promoting or preventing  
9 the nomination or election of any person to public office or  
10 aiding, promoting or antagonizing the interests of any politi-  
11 cal party or influencing or effecting the vote on any question  
12 submitted to the voters.
