

The commission shall have full power to prescribe rules, regulations and conditions under which all horse or dog races at horse or dog racing meetings shall be conducted in the commonwealth and may by rule or regulation prohibit licensees from admitting minors to dog or horse racing meetings.

Chap. 97. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL DEFENSE BE A MEMBER OF AN EMERGENCY COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE NECESSARIES OF LIFE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 9H of chapter 23 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 4 of chapter 261 of the acts of 1939, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—Whenever the governor shall determine that an emergency exists in respect to food or fuel, or any other common necessary of life, including the providing of shelter, or any two or more of such necessities of life, he may, by a writing signed by him, designate the adjutant general, the director of civil defense, the commissioner of labor and industries and the commissioner of public safety to act as an emergency commission, and thereupon the commission shall have, with respect to the necessary or necessities of life as to which the emergency exists, all the powers and authority granted by the Commonwealth Defense Act of nineteen hundred and seventeen, being chapter three hundred and forty-two of the General Acts of nineteen hundred and seventeen, to persons designated or appointed by the governor under section twelve of said chapter three hundred and forty-two; and the governor may revoke such written authority at any time.

Chap. 98. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION ICE SKATING RINK IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AS THE DONALD J. KELLY SKATING RINK.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The metropolitan district commission ice skating rink to be constructed in that part of the city of Cambridge, known as North Cambridge, shall, upon completion, be known and designated as the Donald J. Kelly skating rink, in memory of Donald J. Kelly, whose enthusiasm for the sport of ice hockey contributed greatly to the development of this sport in the city of Cambridge. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be placed thereon by said commission.

Chap. 99. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERK OF COURTS FOR THE COUNTY OF BRISTOL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 5 of chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph, as appearing in chapter 535 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

Bristol, a third assistant, a fourth assistant, a fifth assistant and a sixth assistant, subject to removal by the court or by the clerk.

Chap. 100. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the ninth paragraph the following paragraph:—

A sixth assistant clerk with salary payable by the county may be appointed, subject to the approval of the county commissioners, in the district court of Springfield.

Chap. 101. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF EAST NORFOLK.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fourth paragraph, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 585 of the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

Fifth assistant clerks with salaries payable by the county may be appointed in the municipal court of the Dorchester district and in the district court of East Norfolk.

Chap. 102. AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN HAMPDEN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. *Class I* of paragraph (1) of section 79 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the line reading "district court of eastern Hampden,".

SECTION 2. Said paragraph (1) of said section 79 of said chapter 218 is hereby further amended by striking out *Class II*, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 675 of the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following class:—

Class II. The district court of Chicopee,
 district court of Dukes county,
 district court of eastern Essex,
 district court of eastern Hampden,
 second district court of Essex,
 district court of Nantucket,
 district court of Natick,
 district court of Newburyport and
 second district court of eastern Worcester.
