AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A LIMITED MILITARY RETIREE EXEMPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1988 Official Edition is hereby further amended by adding
3 after paragraph (b), the following: —

4 (c) notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the first
5 three thousand dollars of retirement pay for all retired members
6 of the Armed Forces of the United States, who have attained the
7 age of sixty-five prior to the beginning of the taxable year, shall
8 be exempt from taxation.
