AN ACT TO RENAME CENTER PLAZA AS THE JOHN F. THOMPSON
SQUARE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The area within the city of Boston known as Center
- 2 Plaza shall be hereafter designated and known as John F.
- 3 Thompson square. A suitable marker bearing said designa-
- 4 tion shall be placed thereat.
