The committee on Rules, to whom was referred the order (filed by Messrs. Cavanaugh of Medford, Catino of Medford, McGlynn of Medford and Sacco of Medford) relative to the appointment of a special House committee to make an investigation of the construction of the athletic plant by the Metropolitan District Commission in the city of Medford, the reasons for the delay in the completion of said plant and other related matters (House, No. 3546), report that the same ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the speaker of the house of representatives is
2 hereby authorized to appoint a special committee of seven
3 members of the house to make an immediate investigation rela-
4 tive to the construction of an athletic plant by the metropolitan
5 district commission in the city of Medford, the reason for the
6 delay in the completion of said plant and any other matters
7 relative thereto which said committee deems reasonable and
8 proper. Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the
9 state house or elsewhere and may hold hearings as it deems
10 necessary. Said committee shall report to the house of repre-
11 sentatives the results of its investigation and its recommenda-
12 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to
13 carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with
14 the clerk of the house of representatives not later than the last
15 Wednesday of June in the current year.
