AN ACT

To enforce the Provisions of Chapter Fifty-seven of the Public Statutes, relating to the Inspection and Sale of Milk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Trial justices, police and district
2 courts shall have jurisdiction concurrent with the
3 superior courts of all violations of the provisions
4 of chapter fifty-seven of the Public Statutes,
5 relating to the inspection and sale of milk, and
6 may impose the penalties as therein provided.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
