AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHEDULES OF METROPOLITAN TRANSIT
AUTHORITY VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Metropolitan Transit Authority is hereby directed to
- 2 post in a conspicuous place in all of its stations and terminals
- 3 the schedule of all buses, trackless trolleys and street cars leaving
- 4 said station and terminal.
