AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PEABODY DISTRICT COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of chapter 218, as appearing in the 1986 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "cents"
- 3 in line 110 the following: — "district court of Peabody".
