RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY RELATIVE TO THE USE OF CERTAIN AIR RIGHTS OVER THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE EXTENSION IN THE ALLSTON/BRIGHTON AREA IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of directors of the Massachusetts
2 Turnpike Authority is hereby authorized and directed to make an
3 investigation and study relative to the uses of air rights over the
4 Massachusetts Turnpike Extension in the Allston/Brighton area
5 of the city of Boston. Said directors or their designees shall, in the
6 course of their investigation, examine and confer with appropriate
7 community groups, state legislators and the mayor of the city of
8 Boston about possible residential, commercial and beautification
9 development of said air rights, and the actions necessary to
10 implement said development.

11 Said directors shall report to the joint legislative committee on
12 transportation the results of its investigation, study and con-
13 ferences, its recommendations, if any, including without limita-
14 tion, a schedule for implementation, together with drafts of
15 legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect by
16 filing the same with the clerk of the House of Representatives on or
17 before April first, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.
