

perform his duties, the selectmen may, in like manner, appoint a temporary officer to hold his office, who shall have like powers and duties until such tree warden, highway surveyor or road commissioner resumes his duties or his successor is elected or appointed, as the case may be.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO NAME THE PROPOSED NEW MERIDIAN STREET BRIDGE, CONNECTING EAST BOSTON AND CHELSEA, THE ANDREW P. MCARDLE BRIDGE. Chap. 84

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The city of Boston is hereby authorized to name the proposed new Meridian street bridge, connecting East Boston and Chelsea, the Andrew P. McArdle Bridge in memory of past state commander Andrew P. McArdle of The American Legion.

AN ACT REQUIRING BONDS TO SECURE THE LEVELLING OF SITES OF DEMOLISHED OR REMOVED BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES. Chap. 85

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The last paragraph of section 3 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, added by section 4 of chapter 156 of the acts of 1949, is hereby amended by adding at the end the following: — Before the issue of any such license or permit, the applicant therefor shall file with such officer or board a bond running to the city or town, with sureties satisfactory to such officer or board, in such penal sum as such officer or board shall determine to be twice the cost of levelling the lot as herein required, and conditioned upon such levelling within such time as such officer or board shall determine; provided, however, that no such bond shall be required where such filling and levelling is to be done by a city or town or any board or officer thereof or by any person acting for or under a contract with said city or town or a board or officer thereof.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HOURS OF DUTY OF THE PERMANENT MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE TOWN OF WAKEFIELD. Chap. 86

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The hours of duty of the permanent members of the uniformed fire fighting force in the town of Wakefield, upon acceptance of this act as hereinafter provided, shall be so established by the chief of the fire department that the average weekly hours of duty in any year, other than hours during which such members may be summoned and kept on duty because of conflagrations, shall not exceed fifty-six in number.
