## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Building of a Bathhouse in Brown Park in the Town of Marblehead.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Marblehead is hereby author-  
2 ized to build and maintain a bathhouse in Brown park,  
3 so-called, in the said town, and to raise and appropriate  
4 such sums of money as may be necessary for this purpose.

1 SECTION 2. The park commissioners of said town shall  
2 have the care and management of the bathhouse and the  
3 land appurtenant thereto and may make such rules and  
4 regulations for the conduct of the bathhouse as they may  
5 consider necessary, and if they deem it expedient may  
6 charge non-residents of the town for the use of the same.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its ac-  
2 ceptance by a majority of the voters of the town of  
3 Marblehead voting thereon at an annual or special meet-  
4 ing called for the purpose.

1 SECTION 4. So far as authorizing its submission to the  
2 voters of the town of Marblehead is concerned, this act  
3 shall take effect upon its passage.
