Chap. 224. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TREASURER OF ESSEX COUNTY TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO SPRING HILL FARM DAIRY, INC. OF THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The treasurer of Essex county, with the approval of the county commissioners of said county, is hereby authorized to pay, from available funds, to Spring Hill Farm Dairy, Inc. of the city of Haverhill an amount not to exceed two thousand seven hundred and thirty-four dollars and seventeen cents for supplying milk to the Lawrence jail and house of correction in the year nineteen hundred and eighty, which bill is legally unenforceable against said county.

SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the county commissioners of said county or paid by said treasurer under authority of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed and filed with said treasurer, stating under penalties of perjury, that the goods for which said bill was submitted were ordered by an official or an employee of said county, and that such goods were rendered to said county.

SECTION 3. Any person who knowingly files a certificate required by section two, which is false, and who thereby received payment for goods which were not received by said county shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars, or both.

Chap. 225. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NANTUCKET TO USE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMERCIAL BOAT PIER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The town of Nantucket is hereby authorized to use a certain parcel of land acquired by said town for the purposes of clause (53) of section five of chapter forty of the General Laws, for the construction of a commercial boat pier, for off-loading of commercial items including, but not limited to, stone, gravel, aviation fuel, gasoline, fuel oil, fish and shellfish.

Said parcel being that parcel of land contained in the order of taking made by the selectmen of said town dated December

seventh, nineteen hundred and sixty-six and recorded in the Nantucket registry of deeds, Book 130, page 79.

Chap. 226. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO ALLOW A RATE OR CHARGE FOR DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE SERVICE TO CERTAIN BUSINESS CUSTOMERS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 159 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 12, the words "section nineteen" and inserting in place thereof the words:- sections nineteen and nineteen A.

SECTION 2. The first sentence of section 19 of said chapter 159 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "service", inserted by chapter 218 of the acts of 1979, the words:- to residential customers or the commonwealth or its political subdivisions.

SECTION 3. Said chapter 159 is hereby further amended by inserting after section 19 the following section:-

Section 19A. The department may approve a rate, fare, toll or charge for directory assistance service to business customers pursuant to schedules filed with the department; provided, however, that for each business line to which a business customer subscribes, said customer shall be entitled to receive an allowance of ten directory assistance calls per month and for each private branch exchange trunk to which said customer subscribes an equivalent allowance of directory assistance calls per month, to be determined by the department; provided, further, that business customers who are certified as handicapped persons pursuant to regulations promulgated by the department shall be allowed an unlimited number of directory assistance calls without charge, and subject to such other terms and conditions as the department finds reasonable; and provided, further, that no rate, fare, toll or charge for directory assistance service may be charged to users of coin operated telephones. The department may approve a rate, fare, toll or charge for directory assistance service to other common carriers as defined in paragraph (d) of section twelve for such directory assistance service provided to business customers as provided for herein; provided, however, that upon the approval of such rate, fare, toll or charge for directory assistance, the depart-
