### **AN ACT TO CLARIFY WORKING WITHOUT COMPENSATION AND INCREASING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 158A of Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the entire section and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following: — “Whoever requires or permits any  
4 person, as a condition of securing employment, to work without  
5 monetary compensation shall be punished by a fine of not more  
6 than \$250.”
