RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO THE ELIMINATION OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC HAZARDS AT MARSTON'S CORNER IN THE TOWN OF METHUEN.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the elimination of the serious traffic hazards at
4 Marston's corner in the town of Methuen. Said department
5 shall report to the general court the results of its investigation
6 and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with
7 drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations
8 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
9 representatives on or before the last Wednesday of December
10 in the current year.
