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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BROCKTON TO USE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF CONSERVATION LAND FOR PARK AND RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 249 of the acts of 1981 is  
2 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 11 to 14, inclusive, the  
3 words "Northerly by Pearl Street 170 feet, more or less; Westerly  
4 by Plot 44-1 Pearl Street, 417 feet, more or less; Southerly 238.8  
5 feet; and Easterly 412 feet, more or less, by Plot 43 Pearl Street to  
6 the point of beginning" and inserting in place the words: — South-  
7 erly by Torrey Street 550 feet, more or less; Westerly and Southerly  
8 by a right of way on a remaining portion of said Plot 45 Pearl Street  
9 350 feet, more or less; Northwesterly by Plots 24 and 23-1 Torrey  
10 Street on said Plan, 370 feet, more or less; and Easterly by the  
11 remainder of Plot 45 Pearl Street, 630 feet, more or less.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
