By Mr. DiMasi of Boston, petition of Salvatore F. DiMasi relative to the penalty for attachment of unauthorized wire, cable or other devices to a transmitting unit of a licensed cable antenna television system. Criminal Justice.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PENALTY FOR ATTACHMENT OF UNAUTHORIZED WIRE, CABLE OR OTHER DEVICES TO A TRANSMITTING UNIT OF A LICENSED SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 166A is hereby amended by striking out the words “not
2 more than one thousand dollars or by imprisonment in the state
3 prison for not more than five years or in a jail or house of correc-
4 tion for not more than two and one-half years or by both such fine
5 and imprisonment,” and by inserting in place thereof the
6 following: — not less than one hundred dollars nor more than one
7 thousand dollars, or by imprisonment in a jail or house of correc-
8 tion for not more than six months, or by both such fine and
9 imprisonment.
