Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Department of Public Safety relative to unifying the Police Departments of the Commonwealth or of Metropolitan Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public safety is
2 hereby authorized and directed to investigate as to the
3 advisability and feasibility of unifying the police depart-
4 ments of the cities and towns of the commonwealth or
5 of the metropolitan Boston, so-called, and the other
6 suggestions of the attorney general in relation thereto
7 contained in his report for the year ending November
8 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five. The de-
9 partment, for the purposes aforesaid, may expend, out
10 of such amount, not exceeding dollars, as the
11 general court shall appropriate, such sums as the gover-
12 nor and council approve, and shall report its recommen-
13 dations, if any, with drafts of any legislation embodying
14 such recommendations, to the general court by filing
15 the same with the clerk of the senate not later than
16 December ^{the} first ^{of} the current year.
