RESOLVE

Upon the Petition of Eunice H. Leonard, Guardian.

Resolved, For reasons set forth in the petition of Eunice H. Leonard, of Norton, in the county of Bristol, that she be and hereby is authorized and empowered, in her capacity as guardian of her daughters, Florence C. Leonard and Henrietta F. Leonard, to convey to her son, Jacob A. Leonard, all the right, title and interest which said daughters have in and to certain land described in a deed from Cromwell Leonard, late of Norton, deceased, to his son, Luen C. Leonard, deceased, dated June fifth, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine: *provided*, that such conveyance shall be made under and according to leave and order of the judge of probate for the county of Bristol, who is hereby authorized to grant such leave, if he shall deem it expedient.
