AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN HOSPITALS MAY DISPENSE
MEDICINES AND PHARMACEUTICALS TO ELDERLY PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 All licensed hospitals which maintain a pharmacy shall dis-
- 2 pense prescription medicines and pharmaceuticals to elderly
- 3 persons at cost prices. For the purposes of this act an elderly
- 4 person is defined as a person who:—
- 5 (a) is receiving a social security pension, or
- 6 (b) is eligible for medicare, or
- 7 (c) is a retired public employee, or
- 8 (d) is sixty-five years of age or over.
