The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COMMONWEALTH REIMBURSE KENNETH S. MOLIN, PRINCIPAL CIVIL ENGINEER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, FOR THE COST OF LEGAL SERVICES INCURRED BY HIM IN DEFENSE OF CERTAIN CRIMINAL CHARGES AGAINST HIM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury,
2 subject to appropriation, to Kenneth S. Molin of Swamp-
3 scott the sum of fifteen thousand dollars as reimbursement
4 for the cost of legal services incurred by him in defense of
5 criminal charges brought against him, as principal civil
6 engineer for the department of public works, for alleged
7 violations of law, and of which he was acquitted in June,
8 nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
