

HOUSE No. 372

Bill accompanying the petition of Benjamin Sharp and another for legislation relative to the shooting of certain wild fowl. Fisheries and Game. January 12.

AN ACT

Relative to the Shooting of Certain Wild Fowl.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to pursue, hunt, take
2 or kill any of the wild fowl included under the name of
3 anatidae during the time between two hours after sunset
4 and two hours before sunrise.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act
2 shall be fined a sum not exceeding fifty dollars for each
3 bird in respect to which the violation occurs.
