AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 43 the following section: —

3 Section 43A. At least one member of the commission shall be
4 a person with five or more years experience as a licensee under
5 section twelve or section fifteen of chapter one hundred and thirty-
6 eight. For the purposes of this section the term "licensee" shall
7 mean an individual holder of a license, an officer, director or
8 owner of at least twenty per cent of the stock of a corporate holder
9 of a license, or a partner of a partnership holder of a license.
