RESOLVE

To provide for an Additional Appropriation for the Enforcement of the Fish and Game Laws.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of
2 the treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not ex-
3 ceeding six thousand four hundred dollars, to be
4 expended by the commission on fisheries and game
5 for the enforcement of the fish and game laws; this
6 sum to be in addition to the sum heretofore appro-
7 priated for the said purpose.
