

SENATE No. 95.

To accompany the petition of Frank J. Linehan that the children's institutions department and the paupers' institutions department in the city of Boston shall each be in charge of a single commissioner. Cities.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To provide for a Single Commissioner in Charge of the Children's Institutions Department and a Single Commissioner in Charge of the Paupers' Institutions Department of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor of the city of Boston shall
2 appoint, subject to confirmation by the board of alder-
3 men, a commissioner who shall have charge of the chil-
4 dren's institutions department of said city and who shall
5 be designated as the children's institutions department
6 commissioner, and also a commissioner who shall have
7 charge of the paupers' institutions department of said
8 city and who shall be designated as the paupers' insti-
9 tutions department commissioner. Each of said officers

10 shall be citizens or taxpayers of said city and they shall
11 each receive such compensation as the city council may
12 by ordinance determine.

1 SECTION 2. So much of chapter three hundred and
2 ninety-five of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-seven as is inconsistent herewith is hereby re-
4 pealed and the terms of office of the trustees heretofore
5 in charge of said departments shall expire upon the
6 appointment and confirmation of said commissioners.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the city council of the city of Boston.
