AN ACT

Concerning the Common Lands in the Island of Nantucket.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECT. 1. The occupant, or owner, of unenclosed
2 land on the island of Nantucket, when used only for
3 depasturing, shall not be required to pay for any
4 portion of the partition fences standing on the line
5 between the same land and the land of the enclo-
6 sure of any other occupant or owner.

1 SECT. 2. That so much of the twelfth section of
2 the nineteenth chapter of the Revised Statutes, as
3 provides for such payment, is hereby repealed.
