

HOUSE...No. 69.

[Amendment to an Act in further addition to an Act concerning Hawkers, Pedlers and Petty Chapmen. Proposed by Mr. Leonard, of Bridgewater.]

In the first section, and in the sixth line, after the word part, add the following :

Also, clocks, combs, boots, shoes, blacking, brushes, buttons, cigars, glass and tin ware, and all articles manufactured of silver or gold, or of which silver or gold shall form component parts.

Strike out the second section, and add the following, viz :

1 SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the first sec-
2 tion of this Act, and also the Act to which this is in
3 addition, shall have effect, and be enforced only
4 against such person or persons, as have not obtained
5 a license, as is hereinafter described and provided ;
6 and it shall be lawful for any person, having first ob-
7 tained such license, to go from town to town, or from
8 place to place, within this Commonwealth, carrying
9 to sell, exposing for sale, or selling, any goods, wares,
10 or merchandize, whatsoever, anything in the afore-
11 named section or Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

1 SEC. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That the Mayor
2 and Aldermen of the City of Boston, and the Select-

3 men of the several Towns and Districts within this
4 Commonwealth, are hereby authorized and required,
5 on application of any citizen of their respective City,
6 Town, or District, for a license, as aforesaid, such
7 person having satisfied the Mayor and Aldermen, or
8 Selectmen, (as the case may be) that his moral
9 character is good, to grant such person or persons
10 such license, in the words following, to wit :

11 The undersigned, Mayor and Aldermen, or Select-
12 men, (as the case may be) of (here insert the place)
13 hereby certify, that (here insert the name of appli-
14 cant for license) is a person of good moral charac-
15 ter, and he is hereby authorized to travel, on foot, or
16 with horse, or horses, in any part of this Common-
17 wealth, with leave to sell any goods, wares, or mer-
18 chandize, whatsoever, within or in any part of said
19 Commonwealth, for the term of one year from the
20 date hereof.

21 (Dated, and signed by the Mayor and Aldermen,
22 or Selectmen, as the case may be.)

1 SEC. 4. *Be it further enacted*, That this Act shall
2 have effect, from and after the first day of May next ;
3 and all Acts, or parts of Acts, inconsistent with this
4 Act, are hereby repealed.
