AN ACT TO ELIMINATE AN AMBIGUITY IN AUTHORIZATION OF COMPENSATION AND MEDICAL PAYMENTS BY A SINGLE MEMBER OF THE INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Said Chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 deleting the fourth sentence, Section 7, as most recently amended
3 by Chapter 483 of the Acts of 1979, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following sentence.

5 If the member determines that weekly compensation should be
6 modified or terminated, he shall forthwith file a written order
7 modifying or discontinuing weekly compensation.
