AN ACT CLARIFYING CERTAIN EFFECTIVE DATES IN THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section two A of chapter one
2 hundred and fifty-two of the General Laws, section sixty-five of
3 chapter one hundred fifty-two, inserted by section fifty-five of
4 chapter five hundred seventy-two of the acts of nineteen hundred
5 eighty-five, shall have application to injuries occurring on or after
6 December tenth, nineteen hundred eighty-five, except for injuries
7 for which compensation is payable under sections thirty-four B
8 and thirty-five C, for which said section sixty-five shall have
9 application irrespective of the date of injury.
