AN ACT PERMITTING STUDENTS ATTENDING PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING TO PAY THE ANNUAL TUITION OVER A PERIOD OF FIFTEEN YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1D of chapter 15 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 2 of chapter 611 of the acts of 1972, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 Any student who resides in the commonwealth and attends a
- 5 public institution of higher learning may pay each year's tuition in
- 6 equal annual installments over a period of fifteen years commencing
- 7 on a date fixed by the board of higher education.
