An Act to provide for the Distribution to Cities and Towns of the Amounts received by the Commonwealth for Inheritance Taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter fifty-eight of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section eighteen the fol-  
3 lowing new section: —

4 *Section 18A.* The state treasurer shall annually  
5 on or before November twentieth distribute to the  
6 several cities and towns, in proportion to the state  
7 tax imposed upon such cities and towns in that year,  
8 the proceeds of the taxes collected by the common-  
9 wealth on legacies and succession taxes under chap-  
10 ter sixty-five, after deducting a sum sufficient to re-  
11 imburse the commonwealth for the expenses incurred  
12 in the collection of said taxes.

### The Constitution of the State

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
