AN ACT RELATIVE TO TELEPHONE SOLICITATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,
- 2 it shall be unlawful to solicit by telephone dialing in numbered
- 3 sequence either mechanically or manually. Any person who
- 4 violates this act shall be fined five hundred dollars or im-
- 5 prisoned for three months, or both.
