AN ACT RELATIVE TO INSURANCE REBATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
2 regulation shall be established by the Insurance Commission,
3 which requires insurance companies to offer a rebate, the amount
4 of which, shall be determined by the Insurance Commissioner, to
5 those drivers who pass a defensive driving course. The course
6 should be designed and administered by the Registry of Motor
7 Vehicles.
