AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PUNISHMENT FOR CERTAIN SEX CRIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 103 the following section:—
3 *Section 104.* Notwithstanding any provision of law
4 to the contrary, any person convicted of the crime of
5 rape of a minor, or of sodomy, incest, lewd and lascivious
6 misconduct, unnatural act or indecent exposure in which
7 a minor is involved, or of carnal abuse of a child or of an
8 attempt to commit any of the said crimes, shall be
9 punished by imprisonment in the state prison for a term
10 of not less than three years nor more than twenty years.
