### AN ACT TO DEFINE "APPROVED SCHOOL PROJECT".

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The definition of "Approved School Project": in Section 5 of
- 2 Chapter 645 of the Acts of 1948, is hereby amended by inserting
- 3 after the third sentence the following sentence: Approved School
- 4 Project shall also mean any project for the acquisition and installa-
- 5 tion of state of the art equipment or the replacement of obsolete
- 6 equipment utilized in vocational education prog--approved under
- 7 Chapter 74 of the General Laws.
